Real wood veneer and spruce

USE AND FUNCTION

High-quality profile for technical and visual skirting between floor covering and wall.

This information sheet contains important suggestions with respect to the materials and their treatment. Read it carefully and preserve it with care.

STORAGE CONDITIONS

- Store the profiles upright or on a flat surface
- Protect from moisture
- Protection from sunlight
- Protect from exposure to chemical substances
- Ideal storage temperature 18°C
- Storage at humidity of 55 - 70%

Consequential damage due to improper storage

- Colour changes on the surface
- Damage to the lacquer coating
- Crack formation
- Curvature, twisting
- Dimensional differences due to shrinkage and swelling
- Delamination of the decor material

BACKGROUND AND WALLS

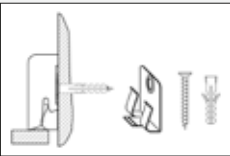
- Dry
- Free from dust
- Straight
- Resistant



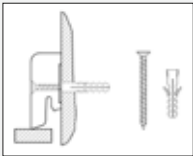
- Proof the stability and possible cavities of the wall
- Adjust and compensate irregularities

UTILIZATION

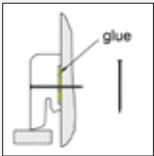
- Choice of the preferred installation way depending on the features of the wall (dry, plasterboards, concrete, wood and/or others):



Clipstar



Screws and
dowels



Spikes
and/or glue

Following steps:

1. Measuring the wall length
2. Cut the skirting boards at length, avoid joints as much as possible and consider in advance if the installation will take place by using plastic corner pieces or by mitering a 45-degree corner at the edges.
3. Depending on the features of the wall, a distance of 25 to 50 cm between clips, screws or spikes is recommended



- Only adhesive tapes with strength (DIN EN 1939 regulation) of max. 2N/cm shall be used.
- Respect safety regulations and use the correct equipment during the installation.

CARE AND DISPOSAL

- Use soft towels or clothes and non-aggressive detergents for regular cleaning
- Remove the dust by using a vacuum cleaner
- Dispose an environmentally friendly way after

dismounting or at the end of the utilization

- Avoid any rubbing or detergents that require rubbing
- Avoid the accumulation of water or liquid products
- Possibility of renewing of the surface by treatment with special product
